For Parents/Carers:

We ask all parents and carers to:

- 1. Support the Club Leader in promoting positive behaviour
- 2. Encourage respectful and responsible behaviour at home
- 3. Ensure children arrive on time and are collected promptly
- 4. Keep contact and medical information up to date
- 5. Inform the Club Leader of any relevant SEND, health or emotional needs
- 6. Treat all children, staff, and other parents with respect
- 7. Raise any concerns privately and calmly

Parents who do not follow this code may be asked to meet with the Club Leader to resolve issues or may be restricted from attending the venue if behaviour poses a risk.
